Executive Proclamation *by* *Governor Sean Parnell*

Under the authority of Article II, Section 9 and Article II, Section 17 of the Alaska Constitution, and in the public interest, I call the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Alaska into its first special session at Juneau, Alaska, in the legislative chambers on April 18, 2011, at 1:00 p.m., to consider the passage of bills on subjects germane to the titles of the following bills while those bills were under consideration by the Senate and House of Representatives during the first regular session:

- HB 108 – Appropriations for the Operating and Loan Program Expenses of State Government
- HB 109 – Mental Health Appropriations
- SB 46 – Capital Appropriations and Appropriations to Capitalize Funds
- SB 76 – Supplemental Appropriations
- HB 104 – Alaska Performance Scholarship Fund
- SB 42 – Power Project: Susitna/Alaska Energy Authority
- HB 106 – Extend the Alaska Coastal Management Program
- SB 84 – Vocational Education and Basic Funding/Tax Credits
- HB 24 – Extend the Regulatory Commission of Alaska
- HB 126 – Extend Boards and Commissions
